## **Presentation of the meeting**

Following the adoption of the ENI CBC Mediterranean Sea Basin Programme by the European Commission and in view of the launch of the first Call for proposals for standard projects, the Managing Authority, in agreement with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, planned a meeting in Rome on the 27 October 2016.

## **Objectives**

The meeting, devoted to the national institutions that will be involved in the promotion, implementation and monitoring of the ENI CBC MED Basin Programme, aims to:

- Analyze the Italian participation in the Programme 2007-2013;
- Present in detail the new 2014-2020 Programme (strategic framework, project type, geographical eligibility, main implementing projects implementation rules);
- Share the outline of the process of mobilization of Italian actors, particularly with regard to advocacy and communication;
- Evoke the resulting responsibilities of the management and control system.
